Prof. Dr. Hong XUE is Beijing Normal University Law Professor, Director of Institute for Internet Policy & Law (IIPL) and Co-Director of UNCITRAL-BNU Joint Certificate Program on International E-Commerce Law (JCP). Prof. Xue is a China-Law-Society elected Top Ten Nationally Distinguished Young Jurists. She is the chief expert drafting the E-Commerce Law appointed by Chinese National People's Congress and National Experts on E-Commerce appointed by China Ministry of Commerce. She is on the Advisory Committee of the United Nations Network of Experts for Paperless Trade in Asia and the Pacific (UNNExT) and Expert Council of APEC E-Commerce Business Alliance. She is the Deputy Director of Internet Governance and International Cooperation of China Association of Cyber-Space Security, Member of Executive Council of China Cyber and Information Law Society of China Law Society, Vice-President of Beijing E-Commerce Academy.

She has been the arbitrator at China International Economic and Trade Arbitration Commission (CIETAC) since 2004, Uniform Domain Name Dispute Resolution Policy (UDRP) Panelist at World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO)

since 2000 and Asia Domain Names Dispute Resolution Centre (ADNDRC) Panelist since 2001.

Before working in Beijing, Prof. Xue taught in law schools in Australia, United States and Hong Kong and was the Residential Fellow of Yale Information Society Project, ICANN ccNSO Councillor and the Chinese Coordinator for Global Academy on Access to Knowledge. Prof. Xue researches international trade law, information technology law, electronic commerce law, intellectual property law and Internet governance and had published hundreds of books and journal articles in Chinese and English. Her recent book *International E-Commerce Law* was granted the award of academic excellency of social science in 2020.
